Research profile Sociologist working on the governance of welfare and protection systems and social inequalities, with a strong background in gender studies. His research examines how public policies and service networks operate in contexts of vulnerability, focusing on the organisation, implementation and outcomes of territorial protection systems.

Gender-based violence constitutes a key empirical domain of his work, through which he analyses support services for victims, perpetrator programmes and policy responses, framing them as part of broader protection regimes.

He adopts a mixed-methods approach combining administrative and survey data with qualitative research on organisations and service networks. His work is characterised by the development of empirical infrastructures — datasets and analytical frameworks — aimed at making policy implementation and system-level dynamics observable and comparable.
